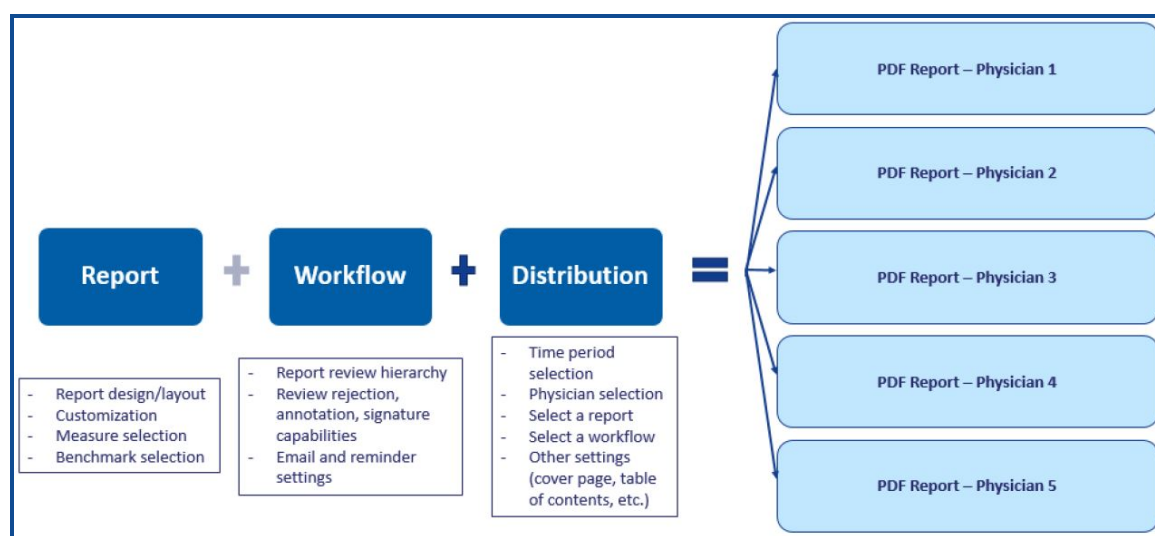
What is PPE Reporting?

Physician Practice Evaluation (PPE) Reporting provides customizable physician or physician group reports with dynamic reporting capabilities to meet physician reporting needs through custom measure and benchmark selection. The reports, workflows and distribution functionality allows for customization and flexibility based on your facility process, each step of the way.

How does the PPE Reporting process work?

The PPE Reporting process is made up of three major components: Reports, Workflows, and Distributions.

- » A PPE Report is a report framework that is created and customized to display data in a variety of ways.
- » A Workflow indicates a hierarchy of who receives the report and settings such as who can annotate and electronically sign the report.
- » The Distribution which sets the report in motion for review and approval. It also selects settings such as physician selection, report tagging, and workflow mapping.



Can reports be customized for physicians or specialties/service lines?

Yes, reports are completely customizable for individual physicians or physician groups. Existing reports can be copied and edited to avoid creating every report from scratch. Specific measures and organizational structure can be selected for each specialty/service line.

Can reports be generated for physician groups?

Yes, reports can be generated for physician groups. The Distribution step is where this can be assigned and finalized. Physician groups can be uploaded as frequently as desired to be utilized throughout Clinical

Analytics.

Is the workflow process electronic or does it require reports to be printed?

PPE reports can be processed completely electronic or can be printed. Clinical Analytics allows both options to meet the particular needs of your organization.

Can reports be emailed to physicians?

Yes, PPE reports can be emailed to physicians. Physician emails can easily be entered, uploaded, and maintained in Clinical Analytics. Clinical Analytics Support can assist with this process if needed.

Can notes be made electronically on reports?

Annotations can be electronically entered on each report. In the workflow step, you can designate which users in the review process can or can't annotate on each report.

Can physicians and report reviewers sign off on reports electronically?

Depending on your organization's process for signing off, reports can be signed either electronically or hand written. There is also the option of saving these signatures on the end of each report.

Can reports be scheduled to run automatically?

Currently, once you have created the report, workflow, and distribution, an administrator must log into the Clinical Analytics PPE Reporting application and click the desired distributions, which run overnight. In the near future, PPE reports will be able to run on an automatic schedule.

What if I need a report now and cannot wait until the nightly run?

Users can export reports on the fly for individual physicians using a PDF icon within the tool. Axiom Clinical Analytics Support can also kick off reports immediately when needed.
